

## For Accuracy :

1. Page **MUST** be printed @ 100% on your printer settings

2. Place a Quarter over the picture to the right. Your Quarter should **NOT** cover the red border. If it does your measurements will be inaccurate.



Groove will exchange any ring that does not fit properly. However, we urge you to visit a local jewelry store or use at least two (2) of the methods below for a proper measurement.


Note: **Groove Ring is designed to be worn snugly on your finger. If your current metal ring is at all loose or you are a half size we recommend SIZING DOWN!!!**

## The String Test

- \*Cut a small piece of string, thread or ribbon from a spool.
- \*MEASURE: Wrap it snugly around your finger for an accurate measurement.
- \*DETERMINE: Overlay your string measurement on the "Paper Test" graphic below.
- \*Tip: Be careful not to wrap the string too tight. Aim for a comfortable, SNUG fit.
- \*Tip: For the most accuracy, have someone help you measure.
- \* CHECK: Double check for accuracy.

## The Paper Test

- \* Print and carefully cut out our paper ring sizer below.
- \* Create a slit by making a small cut on the line labeled "Your Size".
- \* Slip the pointed end through the slit creating a circle.
- \* MEASURE: Place around your finger and pull the pointed end to create a snug fit.
- \* DETERMINE: The number line located at the "Your Size" slit, is the proper ring size.
- \* Tip: Be careful not to wrap the paper too tight. Aim for a comfortable, SNUG fit.
- \* Tip: For the most accuracy, have someone help you measure.
- \* CHECK: Double check for accuracy.



## The Ring Test

- \*Print our chart of ring size circles.
- \* Overlay your existing ring on the circles to the right.
- \* MEASURE: Place the ring on top of each circle until you find a perfect match.
- \* Determine: The match should perfectly fit the **INSIDE** of the ring.
- \* CHECK: Double check for accuracy.
