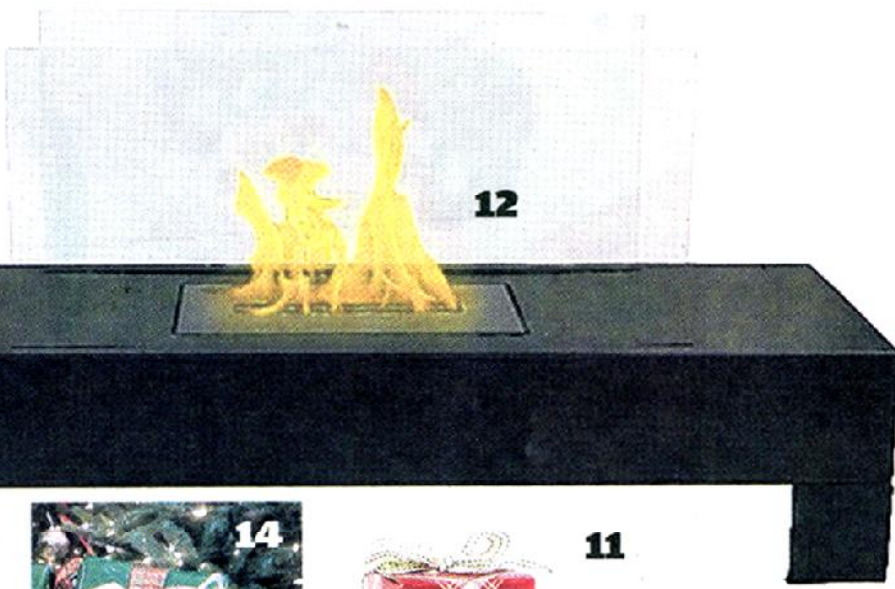

GARDEN POLE



Who would have thought a metal garden pole, like this one, could bring so much beauty to a garden?

Simply slide the pole through the hole in the bottom of a terra-cotta pot.

As you move the pole through a second and third pot, angle the pots. You can use different sizes of pots. The longer the pole, the more pots you can display.

The pole can hang from a tree (that's where I spotted it) or even from a garden trellis.
