

Setting Up

1. Layout all tools and materials on your work surface
2. Pour a small amount of standard school glue onto a disposable surface and spread thinly

Getting Started

Coiling

1. Place one end of the paper strip into the slot of the quilling pen
Tip: leave approximately 1/16" of paper extended from where you threaded the paper strip
2. Begin rotating the quilling pen until the entire strip is coiled
Tip: to ensure an even coil, hold either your thumb or index finger on the very tip of quilling pen slot while your other finger guides the paper strip
3. Slide coil off of the quilling pen using your fingers.
Tip: if a loose or open coil is needed, allow the coil to unravel while guiding it in-between your thumb and index finger until the desired coil size is achieved

Shaping

1. Manipulate coil into desired shape using tweezers to assist
Tip: the coil shape can also be adjusted once it is placed onto the card

Gluing

1. Use your tweezers to gently hold coiled shape by the sides and dip into a thin layer of glue
2. Place shape onto the appropriate place of your card, release tweezers, and briefly push on the top of coil to secure
